Impact Carbon's mission is to improve health and the environment in the developing world through clean energy projects that reduce carbon emissions.

Impact Carbon generates carbon emission reductions from household energy projects that improve living conditions in the less-developed communities we serve. We leverage the financial returns from these projects to benefit local partners and people.

Impact Carbon projects scale the sales and distribution of health and clean energy technologies such as efficient cookstoves and water treatment devices. Impact Carbon works with local companies, philanthropists, carbon finance investors, and NGOs to quantify the carbon emissions reduced by our projects. Impact Carbon is supporting 15 projects in 9 countries.

Impact Carbon is based in San Francisco, CA. The East Africa Regional Director will be based in Kampala, Uganda.

Job Description:

Impact Carbon is searching for an East Africa Regional Director with entrepreneurial drive and leadership experience to develop and implement organizational strategy, grow our East African programs quickly and effectively, and deliver the highest quality programmatic results. Reporting to the Managing Director in San Francisco, the EA Regional Director will build teams, launch new products in Uganda, implement new programs, manage budgets, and drive a coordinated approach to ensure that all programs are managed, monitored and implemented effectively. The Regional Director will also draw on outstanding relationship building skills to create alliances with a diverse range of stakeholders including local distribution channels, government, investors, donors and other NGOs. The Regional Director will represent Impact Carbon at the highest level on both a regional and global scale.

This is a high profile role that is crucial to the success of Impact Carbon. We are looking for an inspirational leader with extensive experience managing companies and/or entrepreneurial NGOs in the developing world.

Roles and Responsibilities:

Impact Carbon programs center around commercial distribution of products that improve health and incomes, and protect the environment. Accordingly, you'll think commercially and have strong experience managing operations that earn income. As the leader of social enterprise programs, you'll also know about leading multi-disciplinary, multi-cultural teams, managing partner and donor relationships, and monitoring and evaluation of social benefit programs.
